Why Armenia?

With a strategic location that bridges Europe and Asia, Armenia's economic upswing has registered considerable attention in recent years. Armenia's average GDP growth from 2021 to 2024 was 8.5% placing it in the Top 20 fastest-growing economies worldwide. Meanwhile, Armenia's GDP per capita adjusted for purchasing power parity (PPP), saw a 335% increase between 2000 and 2024. This growth placed Armenia as the 6th best performer globally in terms of PPP GDP per capita growth. Armenia, on the one hand, is a member of the Eurasian Economic Union; on the other hand, it has a Comprehensive and Enhanced Partnership Agreement with the European Union. The country also enjoys free trade agreements with Vietnam, Singapore, and Serbia, as well as GSP+ regimes with the USA, Norway, and Switzerland. All the above allow the manufacturers in Armenia to access the market of over 1.5 bln. Consumers at 0% customs. The country offers 47 assistance programs for manufacturers, including subsidized loans for the modernization of equipment, an on-the-job training assistance program, certification costs reimbursements, and many more.

Armenia's tech sector landscape has been growing steadily at an average of 22% annually since 2014, with names, as Nvidia, Microsoft, Siemens, Synopsis, VMWare, ServiceTitan, Picsart having their offices in Armenia. The country is in the Top 40 globally in software & data, and among the regional leaders in AI innovation generating annual revenue of over \$2.3 billion. Armenia also heavily invests in tech education with Armath Engineering laboratories installed in all schools of the country, COAF smart centers in the rural areas, as well as TUMO creative technology hubs. The TUMO know-how on tech education has also been franchised to cities including Berlin, Paris, Beirut, Tirana, Tokyo, Hamburg, Buenos Aires, Zurich, Montevideo, etc. as an international best practice on tech education.

Location: Garni Village, Kotayk Province, Armenia

Built in the first century AD, Garni is the only standing Greco-Roman colonnaded temple in the country and a striking example of classical architecture. Its dramatic setting on a cliff overlooking the Azat River gorge makes it a truly breathtaking sight and a testament to Armenia's ancient history.

Geghard Monastery

Location: Geghard Village, Kotayk Province, Armenia

Geghard is a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its stunning monastic complex. The monastery of Geghard contains a number of churches and tombs, most of them cut into the rock, which illustrate the very peak of Armenian medieval architecture. The complex of medieval buildings is set into a landscape of great natural beauty, surrounded by towering cliffs at the entrance to the Azat Valley.
